Reducing health disparities and improving health outcomes, especially in communities inordinately impacted by hunger, are integral components of Feeding America's health equity strategy. Forty network food banks and members of Feeding America's national office staff are collaborating to advance health equity in the charitable food sector to meet neighbors where they are. A key supporter of this work is CVS, which is helping to provide not only food to neighbors in need but other social services that help lower food insecurity rates. CVS' eight-figure, multi-year gift is supporting 191 food banks across the nationwide network.

Record inflation and supply chain disruptions have affected millions of families, as well as the charitable food system. To help bolster the network's response, thousands of Walmart stores and Sam's Clubs teamed up with their customers, members, suppliers and associates for the ninth annual *Fight Hunger. Spark Change.* campaign. As part of the 2022 campaign, which benefited every network member food bank, select members—serving areas with increased barriers to access and racial disparities—received storytelling grants to help share their local impact in partnership with their agencies. This year's campaign also marked a milestone: 7 billion pounds of food donated to member food banks since 2006 through Walmart and Sam's Club's food donation program.

To address our nation's food insecurity crisis, we must examine how it intersects with health. Through the Food is Medicine initiative, 14 food banks strengthened partnerships with local health care organizations in Spring 2022 to serve more patients through food insecurity screenings, enroll in benefits programs like SNAP, improve data collection and offer a wider variety of nutritious foods. For the next three years—in the initiative's third iteration—over 20 food banks will build on this work with the goal of improving patients' food security, diet quality and health outcomes, thanks to a \$14.1 million investment from Elevance Health Foundation.

Among children in the United States in 2021, more than 9 million—1 in 8—were living in food-insecure households, according to the U.S. Department of Agriculture's annual report on food security in the U.S. (released September 2022). Vital awareness for the issue of child hunger, as well as more than 2 million meals for families in need, were raised by Sinclair Broadcast Group through its Summer Hunger Relief campaign. The effort engaged local TV stations and Bally Sports, including more than 52,000 media spots across their platforms, produced news stories, rallied volunteers and more.



Responding to the unprecedented need, new donors provided vital support, including the Malott Family Foundation, who helped food banks continue to demonstrate resolve and resourcefulness to secure food. The family said Feeding America's scale and scope of work, thanks to a powerful and efficient nationwide food bank network, earned their trust to direct funds to areas of greatest impact. Their fiscal year 2022 gift provided matching campaign dollars to a national direct mail campaign, as well as supported meal programs at food banks in Illinois and Minnesota.





Unreliable transportation, lack of a conveniently located grocery store, limited or no understanding of charitable food assistance options—these are just some of the reasons that a family may not have access to the nourishing food they need. That's why the ability to deliver meals to neighbors who face access barriers to food is vital. Free delivery for the more than 200 Feeding America network food banks was provided by DoorDash, which also donated funds that yielded grant support for 20 food banks to help offset their operational costs.

Sustainer donors are donors who commit to a giving plan, with the funds unrestricted, providing flexibility to make investments targeting greatest need. Gleaning timely data and deeper insights about the neighbors served by the Feeding America network is imperative to advancing our work. To achieve this we launched a new, network-wide neighbor intake platform in January 2022 as part of the Service Insights Initiative. The new resource modernizes our data collection practices, allowing food banks and their partner agencies to visualize and analyze neighbor intake data in real time to inform services. The platform, available at no cost to all network members, is made possible thanks to Tableau and its in-kind commitment worth \$4 million.




